Welcome to Grimston Court, set in secluded private grounds on the outskirts of York. This impressive country house was built at the turn of the century for Sir John Hunt by the architect Walter Brierley and is a listed building of historical interest. There are fine views over open parkland and the extensive terraced flower gardens are much admired by our residents. One can sit and relax in our large oak panelled lounge with its magnificent fireplace and the mahogany panelled dining room. Both these rooms feature classical ornate ceilings. This already impressive home was refurbished in 2007 to Wellburn standards to offer the very highest quality of Care.



Our Aim

Our aim is to provide individual care in a relaxed and friendly environment. Everyone has the right to live their life in one's own way and therefore our resident's voice is important to us: we listen, we hear and we act upon - basically providing care without compromise.

Activity, fun, friendship and support

Services and Health

Medical attendance is provided by the local General Practitioners; residents can continue with their own doctor should they be moving within the immediate area.

A Chiropodist visits every six weeks and a visiting Dentist and Optician provide annual 'check-ups', although additional visits are arranged to suit individual needs. Also on hand is a hairdresser who visits every week.

Activities

Stimulation and relaxation is a very important part of the care we offer. We focus on a balance of individual, one to one and group activities. These include board games, topical discussions based on newspaper readings, music and dancing, arts and crafts. Stimulating indoor activity, walking and regular visits to local tourist and historical centres. A Physiotherapist and Aromatherapist carry out regular sessions.

Relaxation

Two separate lounges are available for those enjoying company or quieter moments, with colour television/DVD, in-house film/music library and large print books. We also have poetry reading, reminiscing discussions on days gone by and classical music sessions. There is a lawned area with patio and surrounding gardens.

The local clergy visits regularly, all religions are welcome and individual requirements are respected.

Home Cooking

We are proud of our home cooking and offer a varied menu of traditional dishes. Special diets are catered for. Details of meal times and menus are displayed in our promotional pack provided in each resident's room.

Accommodation is provided for 47 residents, mostly with en-suite rooms. There are nine luxury suites available. Residents may, if they wish, personalise their room with their own furniture and possessions.

There is 24 hour room service, tea and coffee making facilities are available on request. All rooms are equipped with TV and Telephone points. A lift is provided for easy access to first floor rooms.
